Requirements/Deadline May 13, 2022

1. Must be a high school graduate.
 2. Must have a G.P.A. of 2.75 or higher.
 3. Must be going to college for music or art.
 4. Must submit current high school or college transcripts and portfolio.
 5. Submit two or more letters of recommendations.
2. Submit a one page typed essay on why you seek a career in music or art and what you hope to accomplish.

Application

The scholarship is posted the Blackville Music & Art festival website (bmafestival.com) and it is also mailed to guidance counselors, art & music teachers.

Selection

Via application and portfolio/audition, the student must prove to be of substantial talent and show promise for continued excellence in education and music or art.

Award

This is a one-time \$500 scholarship upon college acceptance.

Disbursement

The funds are disbursed prior to the beginning of the fall semester.

Visual & Performing Art Sample Requirements

1. Pick an area under which you wish to be reviewed based on the sample(s) you are providing.
2. Read the below sample requirements for each area and submit a sample accordingly.

SAMPLE TIPS

- Submit samples on a flash drive, cd, dvd or an online portfolio (ie...Facebook, pintrest etc...) so the reviewers can determine a consistent trend in your skill and potential.
- Pic your samples based on how strongly you feel your skills are demonstrated in them.
- (Image Uploads) Name each upload "Student Name – Title of Piece – Dimensions – Medium" (e.g. Jane Doe – Sky – 11in x 12in – charcoal on paper).
- (Video Uploads) Name your piece "Student Name – Title of Piece"
- **Be aware of the lighting of your piece.** If you have to take a picture of your sample, be sure to take a close up picture with enough lighting for reviewers to see the detail of your work.
- Drawing, illustrations, paintings, sculptures, and fashion design: Each sample upload should focus on **one** piece and should not show multiple pieces.
